### April 2022 TF Sale:

The next Trotteur Francais sale for aged racehorses will take place on the first week of April. The sale is open to all members but is offered on a first come first serve basis. The 2022 sale price for all TF purchased is set to increase by €500 from 2021 which means the price for all new TF horses is now €4500 in this upcoming sale. The additional cost to the sale price is being put towards the expansion of the trotting breeding programme.

All interested members in purchasing a TF horse through this sale should contact the IHRA office.



A reminder to all trainers that the 2022 trainer declaration portal is now open on the IHRA website. All horses must be in declared in training for at least 28 days before being cleared to race. For any trainer wishing to compete on the season opening on March 27<sup>th</sup> 2022, they must submit their horses in training by this coming **Friday 25<sup>th</sup> February**.
