Stewards Report

Race 1: All 4 Ran. No. 3 Jezebels Greggane and No. 4 Janes Rose were both unplaced as they exceeded the permitted number of strides in a gallop. No other issues.

Race 2: Two non-runners, No.4 Romanz and No.6 Dimanjio. 8 Ran. No issues.

Race 3: All 9 Ran. No.5 Empereur Souverain and No.9 Humour De Cosse were both unplaced for exceeding the permitted number of strides in a gallop. The Stewards interviewed Driver Calvin Broughan in relation to his use of the whip and it was deemed to be a Major Infringement. Mr. Broughan accepted this, was fined €75 and given a two raceday whip suspension. There were no other issues.

Race 4: All 6 Ran. Driver Robert Barry was interviewed by the Stewards in relation to why he didn't follow the correct warm up protocols and for failing to bring his horse up to the starting gate when under Starters orders. He claimed that he missed the Drivers briefing before racing and that it was his first drive in a number of years. Mr.Barry was told that the Stewards didn't accept his explanation. It was also believed his horse Ayr Corleon wasn't running to it's true potential. He was given an official warning as to his future conduct. No other issues.

Race 5: All 9 Ran. No.1 Brutenor was unplaced due to exceeding the permitted number of strides in a gallop. No other issues.

Race 6: No.4, Rhyds Eye Kandy was a non-runner. 6 Ran. No issues.

Race 7: No.10 Biniou Du Beuvron was withdrawn when his Driver was un-seated at the start and he got loose before eventually being caught. Thankfully there was no injuries to Horse or Driver. 8 Ran. No.5 Homa, No.6 Hypsee and No.8 Boyardo were all unplaced due to exceeding the permitted number of strides in a gallop. No other issues.

Race 8: All 10 Ran. No issues.

Race 9: All 8 Ran. No.3 Eliano Love was unplaced due to exceeding the permitted number of strides in a gallop. No other issues.

Following Racing there were two horses seen working out on the track. The two Drivers involved were Wayne McNevin and Ray Sheridan. Both Drivers weren't wearing Helmets, Back Protectors or Racing Colours and didn't ask for permission to work out horses on the track after racing. They were asked to return to the Paddock immediately but still attempted to work out the horses. Both Drivers were requested to appear before the Stewards at the next Race Meeting.
