Race 1

All go; no driving changes; No3 Ha Penny Chance disqualified for taking the wrong course, driver C Foran interviewed after race regarding this matter and said he didn't see the line of pegs marking the track and it wasn't intentional; No other issues reported

Race 2

All go; no driving changes; Driver Micheal Hamilton interviewed by stewards for extreme use of the whip in the final eighth of the race, fined €75 and banned from carrying a whip on his next race days. This was his first offence under the whip rule; No other issues reported

Race 3

All go; no driving changes; Hypsee, Humour De Cosse, Cyclone Decouriere and Homa all unplaced after going over the maximum strides permitted in a break; No other issues reported

Race 4

One non-runner Oakwood Amari; No driving changes; B Roche fined €25 leg down; R Manning fined €75 and banned from carrying a whip on his next two race days; No other issues reported

Race 5

One non-runner Kenosha Comet; No driving changes; Noel Cowden ask the stewards to view the footage of this race as he felt his horse had been impeded due to team driving involving B Roche and J Roche jnr . After watching the footage of this race the stewards could see no evidence of this, no action taken; B Roche fined €25 leg down; No other issues reported

Race 6

All run; no driving changes; No issues reported in this race

Race 7

All run;no driving changes; Boyardo unplaced after going over the maximum strides permitted in a break; No other issues reported

Race 8

All run; no driving changes; Dusty Jiel and Epsom De Corvees both unplaced after going over the maximum strides permitted in a break; No other issues reported

Race 9

One non-runner Mooreside Captain; B Roche drives no two Imperial Attitude; No other issues reported

Race 10

All go no driving changes; Troy Mc Aleer fined €25 leg down; No other issues reported

Race stewards interviewed Wayne Mc Nevin regarding an incident that occurred after racing at the previous meeting at this venue . He was asked to leave the track as there was no working out horses allowed after racing but continued and on and ignored the instruction from D Sheehy. He said he wasn't aware of this and apologised and said he did leave the track when asked, he was given a warning and fined €50 no other action taken.
